We want to share some Montessori inspired activities and ideas for the month of October you can enjoy with your child this season.

1. Embrace nature:

As the leaves change and the weather cools, take your child on nature walks to explore the beauty of the season. Collect leaves, pinecones, acorns and use them for art projects and nature inspired sensory activities. Discuss the changing colors and patterns in the natural world.

2. Practical Life skills:

Montessori emphasises the importance of practical life skills. Encourage your child to participate in everyday activities like setting the table, pouring water, folding clothes. These tasks build independence and fine motor skills.

3. Prepare a fall snack together:

Involve your child in preparing a simple fall snack, like slicing apples and making pumpkin muffins. Let them measure ingredients, mix, and explore the sensory aspects of cooking. This promotes maths skills, sensory awareness and practical life skills.

4. Explore sensorial materials:

Create sensory bins using items like dried beans, rice, or autumn theme objects. Let your child explore different textures, colors, and shapes. Sensory play enhances their tactile perception and creativity.

5. Montessori reading corner:

Set up a cozy reading nook with a variety of books for your child to choose from. Allow them to pick their own reading material or read independently or with you. Encourage discussions about the stories and characters to promote language and comprehension skills.
